

## How to get audiobooks and eBooks using an Android Device

The OverDrive app is a great way to quickly borrow and enjoy eBooks and audiobooks from your library.

If you'd rather enjoy titles without installing an app, you can use your web browser to read OverDrive Read eBooks.

When you sign up for an OverDrive account, you can save your libraries and enjoy other great features.

**Note:** If you're using a legacy version of our app, you can find a library using the "Get Books" feature, and you won't be prompted to create or log into an OverDrive account.

## How to borrow titles on your Android Device

1. Install OverDrive's app from Google Play, the Amazon Appstore, or [app.overdrive.com](http://app.overdrive.com), and sign up for (or sign into) your OverDrive account.

From the app, click on Manage Library and search for Howard Miller. Then choose "Lakeland Library Cooperative" and find Howard Miller in the list of libraries.

**Note:** The **Menu** button typically looks

like this  or this .

2. On your library website, look for a title that's available to borrow. You can:

- Browse the titles on the home page.
- Use the menu at the top of the page to browse categories.
- Run a search.

3. When you find a title that looks interesting, tap on the title, then tap **Borrow** to check it out.

Or, tap **more** to view the title's details page. From here, tap **Borrow** to check it out.

If prompted, sign in.

5. Find borrowed titles under your account on your library's OverDrive. They will be under LOANS. You may get there by clicking on the three book icon. You can:

Download EPUB eBooks\* and MP3 audiobooks directly to the OverDrive app.

Tap **Bookshelf** (app menu) to open and read eBooks or listen to audiobooks right from your app.

If you've installed the Kindle reading app from the Google Play store on your NOOK, you can select **Kindle Book** to complete checkout on Amazon's website and send the book to your Kindle reading app. (**Lindsey does not recommend this**)

### **To Return:**

Go to your Bookshelf. Click either Edit (top right) or the three dots next to the book title. Choose "Return to library."
