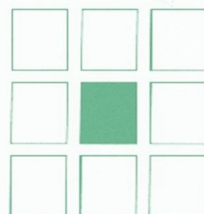

## Getting started with NOOK Tablets

You can use the OverDrive app to borrow and enjoy eBooks and audiobooks from your library on your NOOK tablet (such as the NOOK HD or HD+).

*Note: Some digital formats may not be available from all libraries.*


You will need your library card number to download materials on your device.

### Getting started with NOOK Tablets

1. Download the OverDrive app from one of the following:  
Google Play  
NOOK Apps Store
2. Open the OverDrive app and follow the prompts to create an OverDrive account and log in. If you're under 13, select **I am under 13 years old** instead.

Note: If you're using a NOOK Color or Tablet, skip this step and move on to step 3.

3. In the OverDrive app, find your library. On most NOOK tablets, you can do this by swiping from left to right to open the **Home menu**, then tapping **Add a library**. On a NOOK Color or

Tablet, tap the  icon (or, if you don't have this icon, go to *Menu > Lakeland Library Cooperative*).

Tap the star to save your library to your library list.

Tap your library's name to start browsing.

4. Log into your library's OverDrive website with your library card and borrow a title.

5. Find borrowed titles under your account on your library's OverDrive. They will be under LOANS. You may get there by clicking on the three book icon. You can:

Download EPUB eBooks\* and MP3 audiobooks directly to the OverDrive app.

Tap **Bookshelf** (app menu) to open and read eBooks or listen to audiobooks right from your app.

If you've installed the Kindle reading app from the Google Play store on your NOOK, you can select **Kindle Book** to complete checkout on Amazon's website and send the book to your Kindle reading app. (**Lindsey does not recommend this**)

*\*Note: If you're using a NOOK Color or Tablet, you'll need to authorize your device with an Adobe ID to download EPUB eBooks. It's a one-time, free process that takes just moments to complete.*

#### **To Return:**

Go to your Bookshelf. Click either Edit (top right) or the three dots next to the book title. Choose "Return to library."
