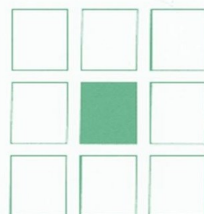

TABLET/ SMARTPHONE DEVICES

What is a tablet?

A tablet is a wireless, portable personal computer with a touch screen interface. The tablet is typically smaller than a notebook computer but larger than a smartphone.

How to get audio-books and eBooks with a Tablet/ smartphone Device

The OverDrive app is a great way to quickly borrow and enjoy eBooks and audiobooks from your library.

If you'd rather enjoy titles without installing an app, you can use your web browser to read OverDrive Read eBooks. To read eBooks directly in your browser, skip to step 4 on the following page. **You will need a wireless connection to do this.**

How to borrow titles on your tablet/smartphone device:

1. Install OverDrive's app from your device's App Store and sign up for (or sign in to) your OverDrive account. ****In order to install the app, make sure you are connected to wireless****

2. From the app, click on Manage Library and search for Howard Miller. Then choose "Lakeland Library Cooperative" and find Howard Miller in the list of libraries. Use your library card to sign in. Be sure to click the "Remember" box so you do not have to type your card number each time you use OverDrive.

3. On your library website, look for a title that's available to borrow. You can:

Browse the titles on the home page.

Use the menu at the top of the page to browse categories.

Run a search.

5. When you find a title that looks interesting, tap on the title, then tap **Borrow** to check it out.

Or, tap **more** to view the title's details page. From here, tap **Borrow** to check it out.

If prompted, sign in.

6. Click on your account icon on the top ribbon and **Checkouts** will open, displaying the title(s) you've borrowed. From here, you can:

Tap **Read (In your browser)** to open the eBook with OverDrive Read. (You must have a wireless connection to read in your browser.)

To Download:

Select a format from the **Download** drop-down menu, then tap **Confirm & Add to App**. (Downloading will allow you to read the ebook/audiobook anywhere, once it has been delivered to the device.)

Select **EPUB eBook** or **MP3 audiobook** to download and add the title to your app bookshelf. **The Confirm and Download.**

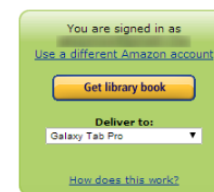
To access the newly downloaded book, return to **OverDrive App's*** main menu (three lines in the top left hand corner) and select your bookshelf. **You are no longer on your library's OverDrive webpage.*

Note: Download time depends on the size of the book and your connection speed. Tablets requires a Wi-Fi connection to download files over 100 MB on tablet devices.

*****If you have a Kindle tablet device, you may either select EPUB (directions above) OR Kindle book (directions below.)*****

If you choose Kindle Book, the download will take you to Amazon's website, where it will ask you to **sign into your Amazon account**. Once signed in, select your device and click **Get Library Book**. A page will open, and you will be asked to select the device you want your ebook/audiobook to be delivered to.

Please note: Once Downloaded, the Kindle Library book will be located on your Kindle's home screen.



To Return:

Go to your Bookshelf. Click either Edit (top right) or the three dots next to the book title. Choose "Return to library."

To Return your Kindle Book

Go to your Amazon account.

Choose **Your Content and Devices**.

Find the book you need to return. Click on the three dots next to the title, under the **Actions** heading.

Click **Return this book**.
